## **REQUIREMENTS FOR CEREMONY BY VIDEO CONFERENCE, if applicable:**

A member of the armed forces of the United States may appear at the marriage ceremony via video conferencing if:

(1) The member of the armed forces is stationed in another country in support of combat or another military operation;

(2) A commissioned officer is present with, and confirms the identity of, the member of the armed forces;

(3) A person authorized to solemnize marriages pursuant to § 36-3-301 is present with, and confirms the identity of, the person who is marrying the member of the armed forces; and

(4) The person who is marrying the member of the armed forces is present in Tennessee.

## If the ceremony is to be performed by video conference, the applicant <u>must</u> so indicate in the affidavit. Otherwise, the marriage ceremony must be performed with both parties personally appearing before the officiant as required by § 36-3-302.
