The commission is directed to elect a chairperson and a secretary and to keep minutes of all its proceedings and transactions. <sup>[1]</sup> Members of the commission are not paid a salary except that any member of the commission who does not already receive a fixed annual salary from the state or the county may receive a per diem of \$25 for each day of actual meeting. All members may be reimbursed for actual necessary expenses incurred in performing the duties of the records commission. <sup>[2]</sup> Although active commissions may meet more regularly, the state law requires that the County Public Records Commission meet at least twice each year. <sup>[3]</sup>
