


## CCFO Program - Courses (Cont.)

- If a participant misses a live class they can attend an alternative class date/ location in the same month.
- At the end of each course there is an exam with 50 multiple choice and T/F questions requiring a minimum passing grade of 70%. Approximately 90% of students pass the first time.
- Monthly course materials are **developed** by the CTAS and peer reviewed by the TN Comptroller's Office LGA.
- Each course consists of several real life examples, exercises, Q&As and group
- Each participant must individually register for each month's class date and location (CTAS can bill for a group of employees for consolidated payment)

## CCFO Program - Courses (Cont.)

- Each county or county BOE employee who completes and passes all 11 CCFO courses will receive a one-time \$1,000 incentive stipend from the TN Comptroller's Office.
- Only county or BOE employees who are NOT elected/appointed officials are eligible for the stipend.
- The one-time \$1,000 stipend is not available to non-county employees of the State of TN, cities, city schools, utility districts, etc.
- If a participant has a life changing event such as job change, birth, death, severe illnesses, COVID-19, etc. the Comptroller's Office will allow a student to complete the program with the next cohort.

## CCFO Program - CPE Requirements

- To maintain an active CCFO Certificate status 16 hours of continuing professional education (CPE) must be completed annually and reported to the TN Comptroller's Office.
- CPE must be in a live training event setting or CTAS financial related training courses. Non-CTAS virtual or self-study CPE must be pre-approved by the Comptroller's Office.
- The TN Comptroller's Office annually provides 16 hours of free CPE to CCFO's; however, attendees and their employers will be responsible for travel costs.
- CTAS offers ongoing free on-line virtual CPE to CCFO graduates.
- CCFO graduates can attend "live" CPE events sponsored by various professional accounting associations such as TASBO, AGA, TGFOA, GFOA, AICPA or TSCPA will qualify.
