Oath of Office (T.C.A. § 67-1-507):

I, _____, assessor of property of the County of _____, State of Tennessee, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will appraise, classify, and assess all taxable property of the County of _____, according to the Constitution of Tennessee and the laws of the state; that I will truly report all persons who fail or refuse to list their taxable property or who have to my knowledge returned a fraudulent list, and that I will faithfully, impartially, and honestly discharge my duties as assessor of property according to the law, to the best of my knowledge and ability, without fear, favor, or affection, so help me God.

Constitutional Oath (also required):

I do solemnly swear to support the constitutions of Tennessee and of the United States and to faithfully perform the duties of assessor which I am about to assume.

Deputy Assessor of Property

Oath of Office (T.C.A. § 67-1-507):

I, _____, deputy assessor of the County of _____, State of Tennessee, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will appraise, classify, and assess all taxable property of the County of _____, according to the Constitution of Tennessee and the laws of the state; that I will truly report all persons who fail or refuse to list their taxable property or who have to my knowledge returned a fraudulent list, and that I will faithfully, impartially, and honestly discharge my duties as deputy assessor of property according to the law, to the best of my knowledge and ability, without fear, favor, or affection, so help me God.

Constitutional Oath (also required):

I do solemnly swear to support the constitutions of Tennessee and of the United States and to faithfully perform the duties of deputy assessor which I am about to assume.
