

Oath of Office — County Trustee

Authority: T.C.A. § 67-5-1901 | TENN. CONST. Art. X, Sec. 1

Oath of Office (Elected):

I do solemnly swear that I will perform with fidelity the duties of the office to which I have been elected, and which I am about to assume. I do solemnly swear to support the constitutions of Tennessee and the United States and to faithfully perform the duties of the office of trustee for _____ County, Tennessee.

Additional Oath at Execution of Bond (T.C.A. § 67-5-1901):

I do solemnly swear that I will faithfully collect and account for all taxes for my county, or cause the same to be done, according to law, and that I will use all lawful means in my power to find out and assess such property as may not have been assessed for taxation in my county, and return a list of the same on settlement.

Deputy Trustee

Substitute "appointed" for "elected":

I do solemnly swear that I will perform with fidelity the duties of the office to which I have been appointed, and which I am about to assume. I do solemnly swear to support the constitutions of Tennessee and the United States and to faithfully perform the duties of the office of deputy trustee for _____ County, Tennessee.
