
#### **UNSAFE WEAPON**

Any weapon that is possessed, used or sold in violation of the law shall be confiscated and declared to be contraband by a <u>court of record</u> exercising criminal jurisdiction. If the weapon was confiscated by a judicial district drug task force, the director of the task force may petition the court for disposal of the weapon (TCA 39-17-1317(a).

If a police chief or sheriff certifies to the court (petitions the court) that a weapon is unsafe or inoperable, the court shall order the weapon destroyed or recycled (TCA 39-17-1317(i)).
